Some of your best sources of information are close at hand. High school counselors, college admission offices, a friend attending college, parents and relatives are great resources! Visit collegescorecard.ed.gov to compare schools side by side on factors like average annual cost, graduation rate and many more.



Some things to consider when choosing a school:

- Does it have the major I'm interested in?
- Do I want a small or large campus?
- Do I want to be close to home?
- What are the costs and average student debt?
- What is the student-to-professor ratio?
- What is the job placement rate?
- What is the school's graduation rate?
- Is the school accredited?

School expenses can vary depending on the campus you attend, the number of credits you take and your transportation and housing choices. The cost of attending college also is affected by your residency. Students who qualify as a state resident usually pay tuition at a substantially reduced rate compared to nonresidents.
